

Annual Work Programme (AWP) 2012: priorities supporting RDP implementation

- The network maintains an annual work programme. The current AWP was approved on 9.3.2012.
- The main priorities of the current AWP are:
 - Communication - Providing two-way information flow on rural development;
 - Cooperation - Promotion of cooperation, networking and good practices exchange;
 - Training – Increase of human capacity at rural stakeholders.
- The NRN activities used to implement its priorities are:
 1. Communication - Providing two-way information flow on rural development;
 - issue expert and informative publications
 - sending weekly electronic newsletter "PRePlet"
 - creation of a new independent website of the RDP
 - a series of short films LEADER
 - participation in fairs
 2. Cooperation - Promotion of cooperation, networking and good practices exchange;
 - meetings of Steering Committee
 - promoting inter-regional and cross-border cooperation
 - organizing Slovenian Rural Parliament
 - participation in the competition for the prize ARGE 2012
 - involving members of the NRN in the activities of the ENRD
 3. Training – Increase of human capacity at rural stakeholders.
 - organizing workshops

2. Thematic Initiatives launched by the Network

- **New thematic issues that the network is planning to address:**
 - How to improve the information access to stakeholders,
 - Local Development Strategy in 2014–2020.
- **Issues addressed by the events:**
 - CAP post 2013,
 - Examples of good practices from the implementation of the RDP 2007–2013.

 - The steering group has been actively involved in the implementation of the Rural Parliament.

- The NSU and the MA staff support inter-regional and transnational cooperation. The NSU distributes propositions from abroad to the members of the NRN, provides presentation about the Slovenian TNC projects' selection and implementation, coordinates LAGs participation at the ENRD LEADER events.
- MA (LEADER Office) provides information about the Slovenian TNC projects selection procedure and implementation.
