Background

The need to improve cooperation between Local Action Groups is recognised as one of the most important areas of work of the Czech National Rural Network. Consequently rural development actors from other European countries were invited to a meeting of Local Action Groups from the Czech Republic – "LeaderFEST" - to support the development of cooperative actions. This event is a follow-up to the successful initial LeaderFEST 2009 conference held in Hradec and Moravicí, which was attended by representatives from eight European countries. This latest LeaderFEST is being held to continue the preparations for the new planning period after 2013 and to help meaningfully coordination the activities required.

Main activities

- A full-day of short presentations and workshops on the topic of the Leader Programme focusing on examples of good practice,
- A rural fair of traditional crafts and products,





- Cultural performances demonstrations of rural culture from different European nations (music, dance, theatre),
- A full-day of short audio-visual programmes on the topic of rural areas,
- Field workshops on various topics related to the development of rural areas,
- An optional excursion to interesting places nearby (activities related to regional and supra-national cooperation),
- Presentation of examples of Rural Development Programme practices.

Main results/benefits

- Exchange of information among actors involved in rural areas (the conference provides a place for various rural groups to hold meetings approx. 240 participants),
- The presentation of attractive places and projects in rural areas within the excursions contribute to the growth of tourism and the initiation of activities related to regional and supra-national cooperation,
- Presentation and collection of information and data about examples of good practice within the LEADER approach,
- Exchange of opinions and suggestions focused on the future of the Leader programme and the development of rural areas during 2014-2020.
