


### **1. Introduction**

Focus Area (FA) 5E is designed to support actions that foster carbon conservation and sequestration in agriculture and forestry.

One of the main ways in which the RDPs aim to achieve this goal is through investments in forest area development and improvements in the viability of forests. A number of RDPs complement this measure with others such as the Agri-environment-climate measure, Knowledge transfer, Cooperation and Advisory Services.

The target is to mobilise 4 billion EUR of public expenditure to support 2 % of the EU agricultural land in contributing to carbon sequestration and conservation.



#### 2. Expected achievements

In addition to the common targets set at EU level, Member States may set programme specific targets which reflect their particular circumstances. Some examples of these indicators are provided below.

#### Examples of programme-specific target indicators

- DE-Niedersach Bremen Reduction of greenhouse gas emissions resulting from the use of moors/bogs: 3 750 tons of CO2 per year
- **ES-Andalucia** % Forest area receiving investments to improve the resilience and value of forest ecosystems: **1.34** %





# 3. Planned total public expenditure on Focus Area 5E




## 4. Intervention logic at EU level


