Key issues and needs/opportunities

- Information /data availability:
 - On innovative actions not commonly used so far
 - Appropriateness of which measures are most beneficial in which biogeographic situations
 - Economic impacts (e.g. Production) of climate actions
- Measure design:
 - Safeguards to avoid non-climate focussed measures having detrimental climate impacts and vice-versa
 - Finding ways to prioritise measures that are beneficial even if their GHG impact cannot be measured in the National Inventory Reports
- Capacity building
 - Improved interaction between agricultural/forestry and climate policy experts
 - Learning from research and practice sharing good practice
 - Guidance materials, advice and training

Possible actions

- Review climate actions implemented in 2014-2020 RDPs:
 - Break down into different aspects (e.g. energy efficiency / land management etc)
- Introduce pilots / pilot networks for testing new adaptation and mitigation measures – territorial approaches?
- Sharing practical examples of what has worked well and where (and what has not worked so well too)
- Advice and knowledge transfer / information exchange:
 - for land managers and other actors in rural areas
 - Between researchers and practitioners
 - Between public agencies
