- **❖ Networking for Operational Groups (sub-measure 16.1): EIP-AGRI NETWORK**
- **♦ Networking re.** Sub-measures **16.2** to **16.10** → **ENRD** possible activities in the short-medium term:
 - RDP analysis: started early stages of understanding how cooperation is going to be implemented
 - <u>Capacity building</u> for MAs, NRNs and LAGs: NRN workshops/meetings, other
 <u>activities possible but not planned yet</u> (e.g. on calls for projects, selection criteria...)
 - <u>Communications</u>: Article on Measure 16 in Rural Review winter 2015 we are looking for contacts from MAs and NSUs to enrich the article
 - Good practices: mostly on processes at the beginning
 - Thematic work: wide scope for activity Thematic Groups 2015-16 first opportunity


