Approach to the ENRD Contact Point self-assessment

- The ENRD CP self-assessment is an internal exercise carried out by the Contact Point to improve its activities and tools.
- It fits into the strategic framewrok for EU Rural Networks → it can contribute to the overall work on the EU Network self-assessment (e.g. provision of data/results collected by the ENRD CP).

 - Indicators (Output & Result indicators)


