

information previously obtained suggests that this training category included measures fostering participatory processes and encouraging innovation. Annual participant figures in this category reached their peak in 2010 and 2011 with 17,558 and 18,637 trainees (in 166 and 411 events respectively), and have been in decline since, achieving a participation of 7,084 persons (in 532 activities) in 2012 and of 499 persons (in just 5 events) in 2013.

Chart 6 below represents an annual breakdown of the NSUs' varied training offer, which also demonstrates that the need of the members of the rural network constituency for this kind of service is a fairly continuous and steady one.
