

# Why are we measuring/assessing?




1. (Mandatory) Annual reporting to MA and EC

2. Annual work programme planning


3. Demonstrating value to Ministers

#### Events

- Event info purpose, audience, location, RDP priority
- ➤ Attendee info interest, gender, age group, residency

### Publications

- E-newsletter registrations, open rates and click throughs
- Magazines and booklets prints and downloads
- Consultations and surveys numbers of responses

### Website and social media

Web hits, Twitter followers, Facebook likes, Vimeo and Flickr views

### Project case studies

Location, RDP priority, total number

- ➤ Impact and legacy
- Publications
  - ➤ What stakeholders want more/less of
  - Awareness level of RDP and other funding
- Website and social media
  - Web analytics linked to clear business objectives.
- Project case studies

  - Cooperation projects developed as a result of NRN intervention




## One example – legacy stats
