

The activities of the ENRD and EIP network

N.B.: this does not mean assessing the Network Support Units

Contact Point, Evaluation Helpdesk and Service Point are service providers in charge of animating the networks.

Even if they animate most networking activities they are not the subject of the assessment

Key Findings

Purpose

- Assess progress towards objectives, results
- To improve the Network activities
- To show the results of the Network activities

Scope

- The Rural Networks tools and activities from Framework
- The benefits / value to stakeholders, target groups
- Extent to which their needs are met









Key Findings

Involvement

- Steering Group prepares proposals, questions
- Assembly amends and approves
- Support units focus on operations
- Support units provide evidence, analysis, methods, guidance

Roles

- Assembly as self assessment relay, champion
- Assembly members prepare for meeting
- Task force of Steering Group to develop RN approach and framework
- Feeds annual activities of networks
