Background

National Rural Networks (NRNs) have proved to be a useful component of rural development policy in 2007 – 2013. Building on positive experiences, the establishment and operation of National Rural Networks will continue in the next programming period.

NRNs are supported by the EAFRD either inside a territorial rural development programme (RDP) or as a separate National Rural Network Programme - NRNP.

They are subject to evaluation, as all other rural development interventions financed by the EAFRD, in order to demonstrate their contribution to the EU rural policy objectives and the development of rural areas.


