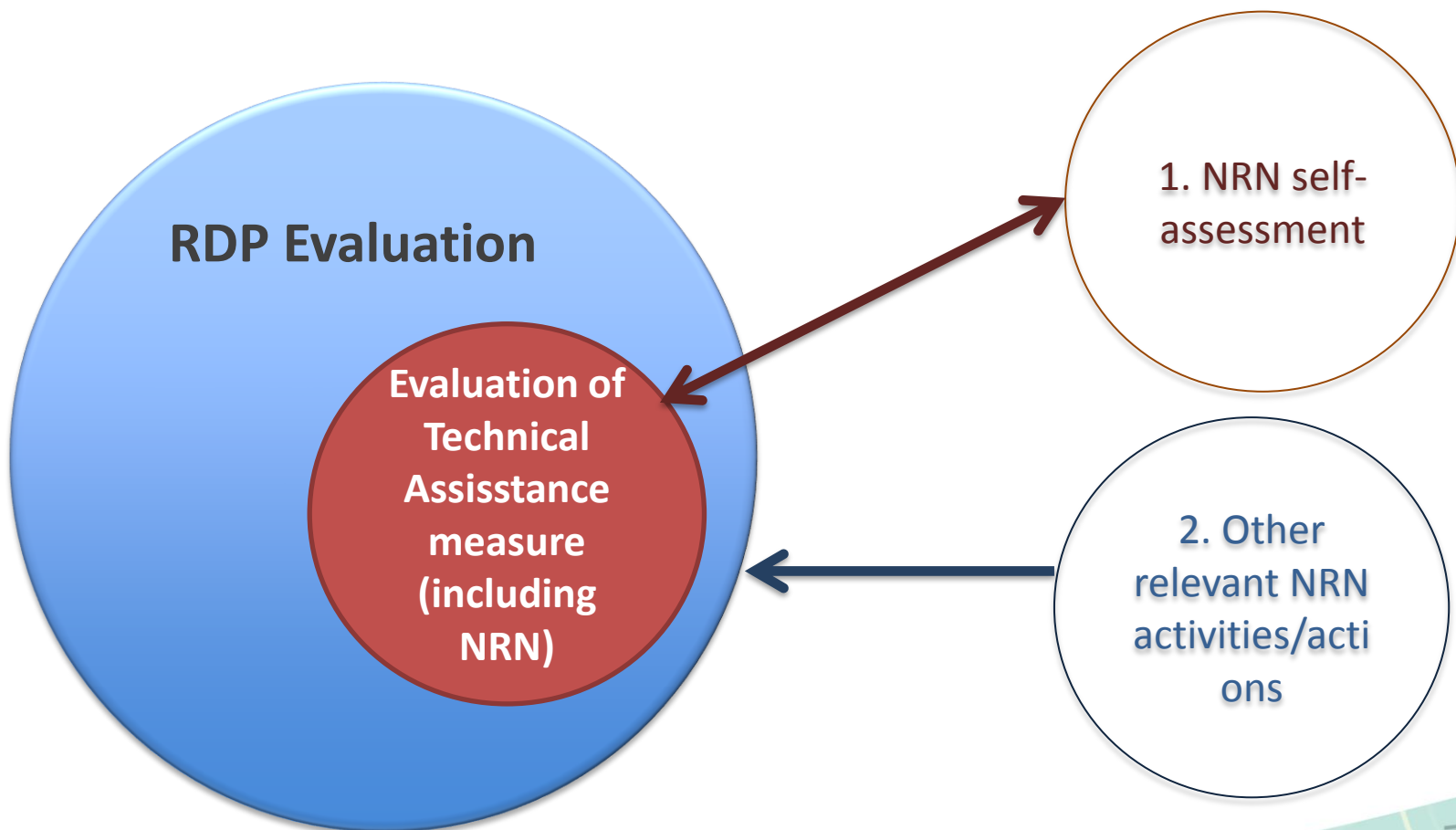

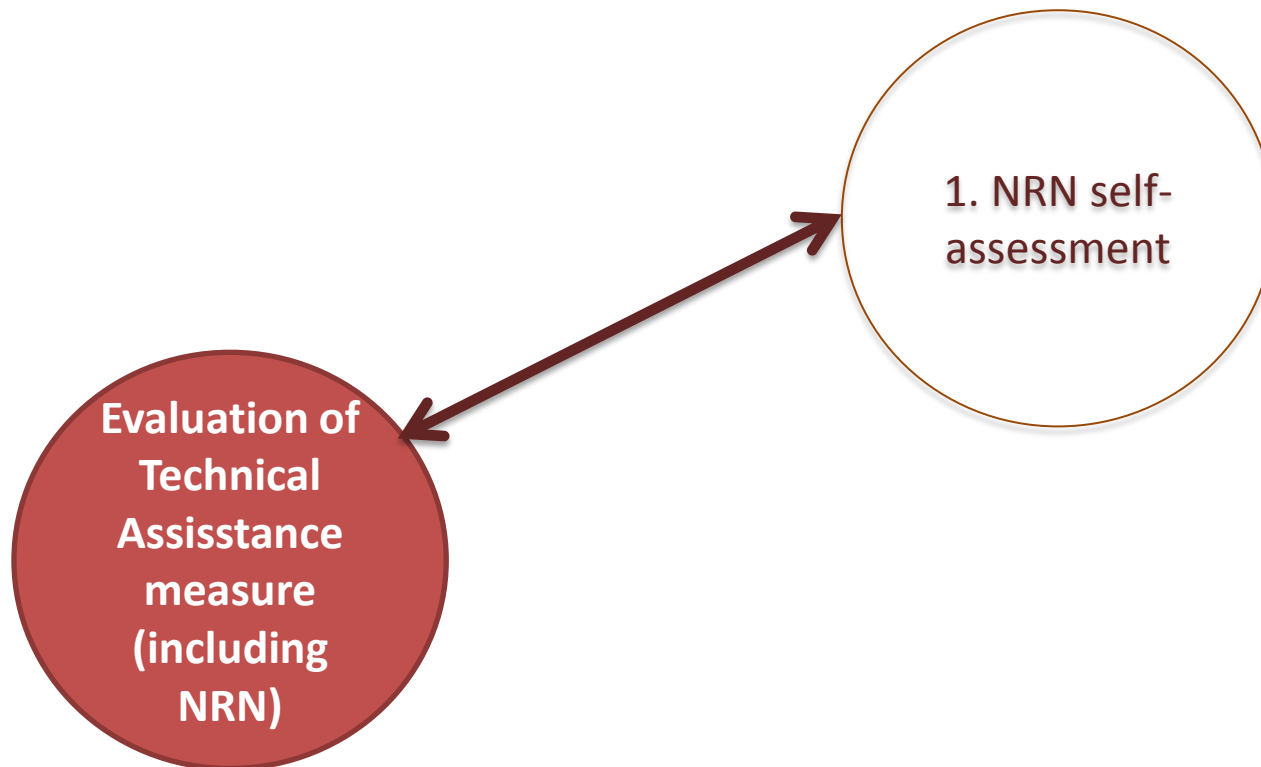

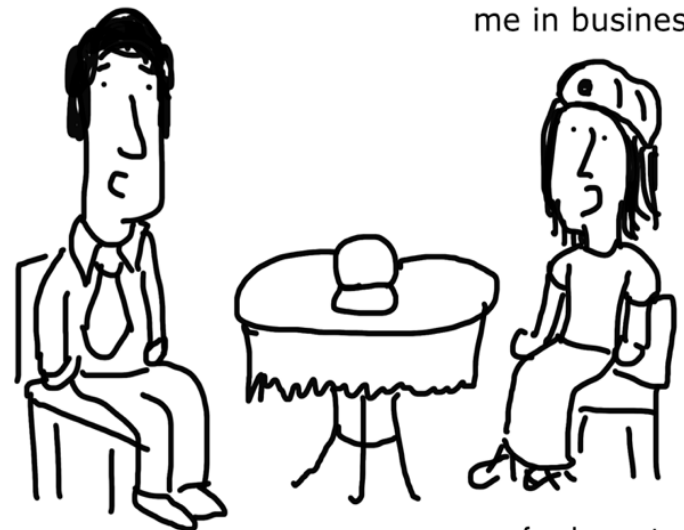
Mutual exchange and learning

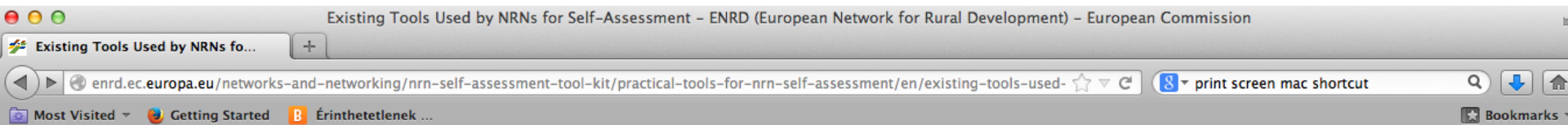

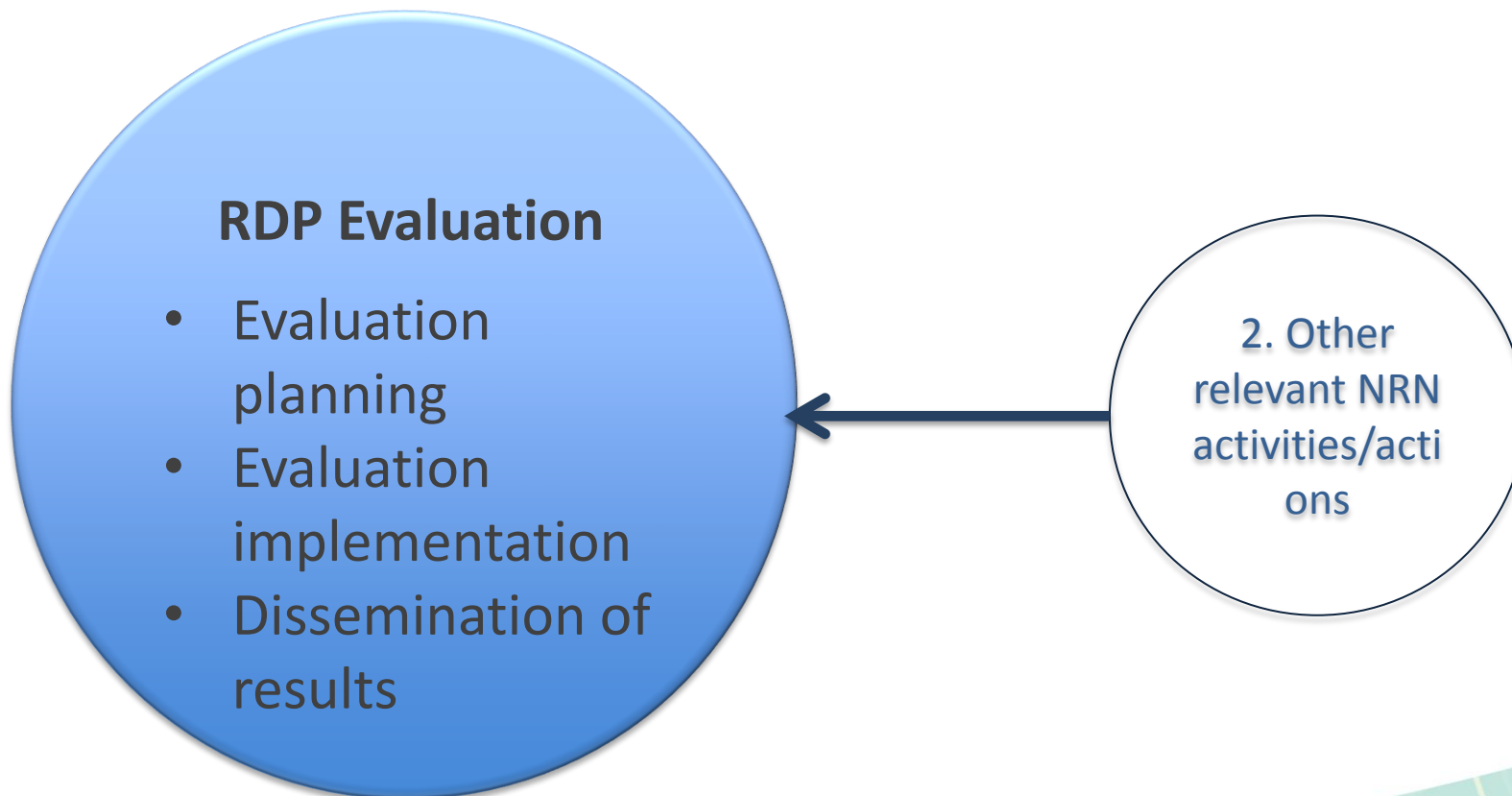

Use of stakeholder contacts in evaluation

- Access of NRNs to wide range of stakeholders
- Channel it into RDP evaluation & programming
- Especially useful for ex-ante evaluation & RDP design/adjustment

The experience of the NL NRN: Interactive working session with various stakeholders (2009) to discuss the complexities of RDP & develop solutions; Review of developments through stakeholder interviews (2013) and suggestions for the next RDP development (2014-20).



Contribution to RDP evaluation

- Assessment of certain aspects of RDP implementation
- Especially, NRN contributions to the evaluation of LEADER

Example of Denmark: The NRN decided to study LEADER implementation in Denmark and explore how the added value of LEADER can be highlighted and measured



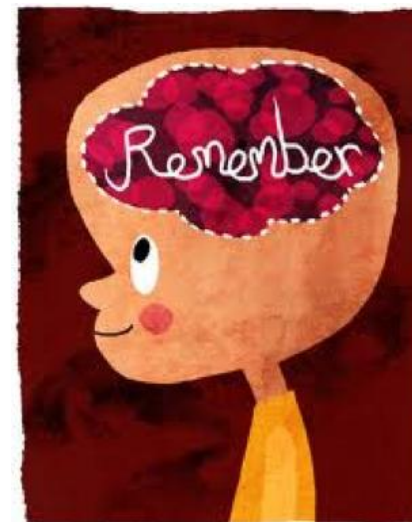
Dissemination of RDP evaluation results

- Raise awareness about the results of RDP evaluation
- Inform stakeholders and generate discussion

Key message...



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NRNs are not only 'evaluation subjects' ...

... they can also be 'evaluation tools'.
