1. Annual Work Programme (AWP) 2012: priorities supporting

RDP implementation

- The network maintains an annual work programme. The current AWP, agreed between the MA and the network providers, has been approved on February 2012.
- The main priority of the current AWP is to carry out actions that create and disseminate information.
- NRN activities used to implement Network's priority include: Strategic Issues Working Groups, Case Studies, Website, Newsletters, Conference and Forum.

2. Thematic Initiatives launched by the Network

- New thematic issues that the rural network is planning to address are: Rural finance and rural youth.
- Continued thematic initiatives and thematic issues addressed through events vary from year to year.
- Issues addressed in working groups are: Farm Partnership, Farm Enterprise, Rural Economy, Climate Change.
- No thematic issue is addressed by committees/steering groups.
- 'LEADER Impact research' is a thematic issues subject of surveys and analysis.
- Information about the thematic activities is available on the publications present on the website.
