


Links between databases



Example: Geographic system


M 312 – Support for business creation and development Distribution of beneficiaries

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Specific challenges

Ensuring consistency in respect of

- Objectives of the evaluation project
- Roles and tasks of different actors
- Interpretation of guidelines
 - Terms (questions)
 - Indicators (observations/estimates, changes/effects, gross/net, short/ long term, detail ...)
 - Monitoring vs evaluation
- Approaches, methods, results

Quality varies substantially

> Reporting, editing, quality assurance


Data and information gathering

Collection (who, when, what), consistency, availability, detail, quality

Lessons learned

> An evaluation **depends** on a budget and specific know-how

- Bringing to bear the know-how of specialised institutes on an evaluation is advisable; it affords
 - > Leadership (focus, objective, guidance, agreements)
 - Organisational and institutional arrangements (project structure)
 - Commitment and cooperation (at the individual level)
 - Definition of roles, tasks and rules
 - Support (data, documents, training, ...)
 - Labour (contributions)
 - Managerial and budgetary flexibility (adjustments, external support)
- > The Managing Authority has a strong stake in evaluation
 - tends to prefer measure-specific evaluations and studies
- Thematic studies are not bound by guidelines; scope and usefulness for evaluation varies widely
