innovative solutions for: organic farming; protein crops; animal husbandry; genetic resources; organic matter content of soils; and integrated pest management.

19 June 2013: ENRD Thematic Initiative on Youth

The First meeting of the ENRD Youth and Young Farmers in Rural Areas Thematic Initiative provided opportunity to take stock of the progress of the work carried out so far, particularly the collection of examples and information at national level, to reflect upon preliminary findings and discuss about what should be improved in the next programming period for the implementation of RDPs which are closer to young people's needs. 20 - 21 June 2013: LeaderFEST 2013

This event was about exchanging knowledge and experience focused on education in rural areas. It was the fourth meeting of LAG representatives and other representatives of rural space who apply the LEADER method in Czech Republic.



The main goal of this <u>festival</u> is to give an opportunity to local authorities, tourist boards, small and medium enterprises, artisans and family farms to exhibit products and services to 20 000 tourists, in the touristic centre of Croatia's Adriatic coast.
