Context of the meeting

This meeting is the first meeting of the Coordination Committee following the presentation of the Commission's legal proposals for the CAP after 2013. An overview of these proposals will be made at the meeting, including networking aspects.

The Coordination Committee will be asked to help design the part of the activities of the ENRD which can help administrations and stakeholders prepare for the future programming period, while ensuring the best use of the remaining time for this current period.

In this context proposals for the launch of thematic focus groups and for a series of targeted workshops will be examined (preparatory documents to be circulated closer to the date of the meeting).

On the day following the Coordination Committee, all members of the Coordination Committee are also invited to participate in the seminar on "Improving delivery of rural development programmes". In this seminar the conclusions of the TWG 4 on the delivery mechanisms of rural development policy will be presented and the proposals for the future policy looked at in more detail in the light of the TWG4 findings.
