#### Do you select the LDS or the LAG?

79% - Both (LAG and LDS)

## In how many phases is the selection process organized?

BL, CY, EE will have 1 phase.

Hu – Have not decided yet

Most of them anwered **2 phases**:

1st- Assessment based on minimal access requirements; 2nd- Assessment based on the quality of LDS(SWOT analysis, thematic compliance with territory needs, etc)

OR

1st-Selection of LAG 2nd – Selection of LDS



### In how many phases is the selection process organized?

OR

1st-Selection of LDS made by 2 external evaluators

2nd - Selection Committee at MA level will make final decision based on the results of 1st. phase.



# How do you do the weighting of all the parameters of the selection criteria? Do you use any formula? Which one?

7 – not decided yet

Different selection criteria (different weighting, expressed in %).

IT – Quality of LDS: 63,5%; Quality of the partnership: 24,1%; Features of the area: 12,4%.

BG – Quality of LDS: 50 points; Capacity building in implementing the strategy: 50 points; Quality of partnership: 10 points; Quality of the process of building a

partnership: 10 points.

## What is the role of the NRN/NSU in the LAG and LDS selection, in your country?

Slovakia and Estonia are the only MS playing a role in the LAG and LDS selection. A representative of NRN/NSU will be part of the MA selection committee for LAG.

#### All the other

- Only informative role and training if needed;
- To give support to the LAGs in the design of their LDS;
- Gathering and disseminate guidelines for LSD;
- Consultant and technical support.

## Which entities/organizations are involved in LDS/LAG selection in your country? What are the tasks/role of each of those entities

MA: BE, IT, HU, SI, SE (Regional and National MA – final approval)

MA and PA: DK (and external experts), LT

Selection Comittee/Technical Evaluation Comittee:

ES – representatives of MA, social and economic sectors of the territory;

EE - Public entities and main stakeholders organizations;

CY - Public entities.



# Which entities/organizations are involved in EDL/GAL selection in your country? What are the tasks/role of each of those entities

MA + Ministry of agriculture + other pubic entities: BG

Local municipalities+PA+Ministry of agriculture (Final decision): LV



Will you have in your country a mono or multifunded CLLD implementation? In each case how do you ensure the coherence of the LDS with the other strategies (of higher level)?

Mono-Funded: BE, BG, EE, LV, ES (or multi-funded depending of the regions)

Multi-Funded: HU, SE, CY, LT

Undecided: SI, IT, SK

Developing: UK, DK (EAFRD, EMFF)

Coherence ensured by good demarcation from the start, coordination of procedures by national entities, guidance on the design of LDS ensuring that LDS fits with national/international priorities.

### What are the themes to be covered by the strategies?

- Priority areas of the RDP, relevant sections of EMFF and i.e.: Short supply chains, supporting social enterprise; Enhancing rural services, natural heritage, tourism, etc:UK;
- LDS are going to be built on these main thematic objectives: promoting social inclusion poverty reduction and economic development in rural areas; environment and resource efficiency, employment promotion and working capital flow: LT.
