Framework

Leader actors must establish strong relations with RDPs and NRN systems

Leader is an initiative characterized by its own specific history, culture, language, users and relations

Leader actors have a general difficulty to establish relations with other rural development experts/organisations/actors working in different regions

Important needs: integration among development policies at regional and local level

Relations and contacts among different actors are more and more facilitated by the improvement of technology and access to information.

Leader actors want to be actively involved in building leader culture, ideas and activities



OBJECTIVES:

For Leader the NRN main scope is to provide communication tools and to bring out the identity of all the Leader stakeholders

- Promoting integration between Leader and the other territorial and rural development policies

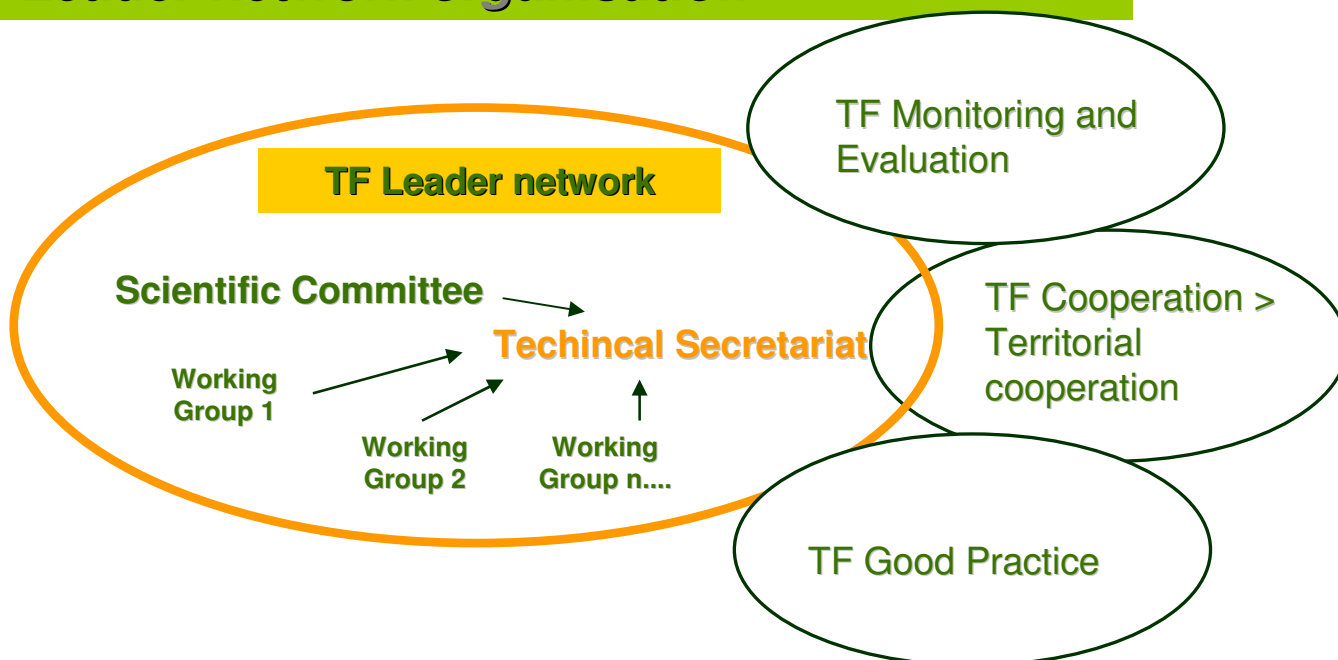
2. NRN "External" communication, information and training

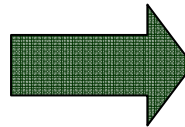
