- Start up phase
- Initial running phase
- Maturity phase







Start-up phase

- Identify important stakeholders
- Form the basic strategy for the network
- Involve the stakeholders to develop the strategy
- Decide on a governance structure
- Create an initial action plan and budget
- Write a communication strategy
- Establish a good connection with the ENRD







Start-up - A basic strategy

- Target groups and how to reach them
- Main focus in the beginning and in the future (axes, type of questions etc)
- Activities
- Publications and web site
- Expected outcomes







Start-up - Governance

- Steering committee with representation from the stakeholders
- How to elect representatives with a rotation
- What will be the competence of the Steering committee
- Outsourcing of services







Initial running phase


- Arrange a few activities to show results rapidly
- Attract more stakeholders
- Produce good basic information
- Offer basic training
- Get active in the ENRD
- Promote cooperation
- Get feed back from stakeholders about the RDP
- Evaluate your performance
- Rotate the representatives in the steering committee
- Make a new action plan and budget
