# SECTION B: **PROGRAMMING AND IMPLEMENTATION OF TRANSNATIONAL COOPERATION PROJECTS**

1. FINANCIAL ASPECTS	
Budget for TNC projects  (Total public funding: EU + public)	There is no specific TNC budget, i.e. funds have neither been pre-allocated to TNC projects nor to the LAGs.  At the moment their local development strategy (LDS) and LAG status was approved, LAGs basically were equipped with an envisaged overall budget estimate for the entire programme period. This budget is the basis for employing measures to implement the LDS, including TNC projects (measure 421 and the measures of axis 3 referred to above).
Responsibility for the management of the Budget (MAs or LAGs)	Not applicable.
Special budget for the preparatory technical support of TNC projects	No specific budget has been put in place for the preparation of TNC projects. However, financing of preparatory actions to initiate a TNC project may be applied for as part of the TNC project application itself.  Eligible project initiation expenditure (excluding VAT) may be financed up to 80%, within a total support limit of EUR 50,000 per project.

2. PROGRAMMING ASPECTS		
Local Development Strategies and TNC	Given the federal state of Hessen's central geographic location in Germany and the resulting absence of external borders with other EU Member States, LAGs were not obliged to implement TNC projects.  The RDP foresees inter-regional cooperation projects and serveral LAGs have stated their intention to cooperate in their local development strategy (LDS) accordingly.  It is, however, generally possible to apply and obtain approval for TNC projects throughout the programme period. Agreement is achieved between the LAGs concerned, the competent administrative district as approval authority and the Ministry of Economy, Transport and Regional Development at federal state level (MA).	
Way of selecting coop- eration projects	Cooperation projects are selected by the LAGs themselves, on the basis of criteria they have included in their LDS. Projects are formally approved by subordinate agencies of the Managing Authority (MA), i.e. the competent administrative district authority.	
Main topics of TNC proposed for the 2007- 2013 programming period	So far implementation activities follow up on a previous cooperation project, the 'Hugenotten- and Waldenser trail'. This illustrates that cooperation projects usually relate to themes, such as:  • Touristic routes and trails;  • Historical, e.g. former Intra-German (east/west) border;  • Joint development of cultural landscapes across borders.	
Cooperation with third countries	Cooperation with third countries is not foreseen.	
Maximum/minimum number of TNC projects per LAG	No requirement has been established concerning the number of TNC projects a LAG may engage in.

Information about procedures of approval and implementation of TNC projects	Other than the EU Cooperation guidelines the procedure follows a supplementary guide issued by the MA, which provides additional information about the management of the project approval and implementation process.

Eligibility criteria for cooperation projects	TNC projects must comply with the requirements of the supplementar guidelines issued by the MA (cf. above website link).	
Selection criteria for cooperation projects	The application for Leader TNC funding is a decision taken by the LAG.	
Eligible activities of measure 421 Cooperation	Eligible activities for TNC project implementation are of non-investment character and include, e.g. feasibility studies and analyses.	
Typical examples of eligible costs for TNC projects	Funding may be granted for services and material costs supporting or directly related project implementation, e.g. for above study and analytical work and to cover translation and travel expenses.	
Specific documents concerning the cooperation partners required from LAGs	Apart from the cooperation agreement according to EU guideline, additional requirements relate to the obligation of the partnering LAGs to provide data and information concerning their joint participation in / financing of the TNC project. The latter includes also the requirement to ensure compliance with regulation (EC) Nr. 1975/2006 (control).	
The approval process of TNC applications	Project applications may be submitted to the competent administrative district authority at any time.	
	LAGs apply separately for their share of the overall budget of the TNC project, taking into account the budget provision they have been envisaged for the programme period.
