

General policy context EU's growth strategy

- Europe 2020 strategy => unlocking the EU's potential for smart, sustainable and inclusive growth
- The EU tools in support of the Europe 2020 strategy include levers for growth and jobs such as the **EU budget**
- EU spending policies to be geared towards Europe 2020
- Large part of EU financial support is delivered through the **EU funds** in shared management (EAFRD, ERDF/CF, ESF, EFF)
- Enhanced coordination of EU policies will be needed for the delivery of the Europe 2020 strategy





Europe 2020 challenges for RD policy

SMART growth:

- Supporting innovation and skills, green technologies and uptake of research
- Providing incentives for social innovation

Rural development

INCLUSIVE growth:

- Unlocking local potential, diversifying rural economies and developing local markets and jobs
- Opening up alternative opportunities to accompany agricultural restructuring


SUSTAINABLE growth:

- Increasing resource efficiency and the provision of public goods
- Reducing GHG emissions, enhancing carbon sequestration and developing bio-energy

Objectives and priorities for RD policy




Key elements EU RD priorities

- Promoting resource efficiency and the transition to a low carbon economy
- Preserving and enhancing ecosystems dependent on agriculture and forestry
- Realising the jobs potential and development of rural areas
