Why to look into delivery mechanisms?

- Delivery mechanisms obviously are important for <u>what and how</u> EAFRD support <u>is delivered.</u>
- Delivery mechanisms are <u>decisive for</u> the <u>outcome</u> of EAFRD interventions and the associated value added.





Issues of interest:

- Description of <u>different delivery systems in</u> <u>place</u> in Member States
- Assessment and review of the <u>strengths</u> and <u>weaknesses</u> of a number of issues related to existing delivery mechanisms
- Identifying best practice to allow further strengthening of the delivery system associated with EAFRD interventions





Examples of possible areas ...

- Programming
 - Analysis, strategy, setting-up of programmes
- Implementation
 - Mechanisms: applications, selection, public procurement
- Monitoring & Evaluation





Examples of possible themes ...

- Strategic approach and targeting of needs
 - Assessment of the current strategic approach.
 Is it an effective tool to ensuring that the funds are directed towards areas of biggest need?
- Rural development "tool-kit"
 - Analysis of the level of detail as regards eligibility criteria.
- Common Monitoring and Evaluation Framework
 - What is the experience of Member States with the main principles (e.g. on-going evaluation, types of indicators, number of common indicators)?
