It should rather be used as a written document to forward to your partners than as a support for an oral presentation. An oral presentation has to go with more interactive supports such as videos and images...

Template structure

Keep this part short. It is just meant to give general background information and to raise important issues concerning what the future project will have to look like (i.e. a common action, orientation on one specific axis of the RDP, etc.) and what the general administrative rules for the project are.
