





#### **240 TNC projects Notified to the EC via SFC 2007**




#### **Total participation in TNC projects per Member States**






## **Number of partners** (1)







#### **Total budget of the projects** (1)









### **Duration of the projects**








#### **TNC projects with third Countries**

CROATIA – 3 UKRAINE - 4 SWITZERLAND – 2 NORWAY - 1 SERBIA -1



# Analysis based on a sample of 22 out of 81 offers posted in 2011 in ENRD website

**❖68%** project applications submitted to relevant authorities

41% projects were approved

Most popular topics of the projects:


√Tourism: 48%

# **LEADER EVENT 2012: Cooperation**







#### **Leader Event 2012: TNC meetings**

- 72 concrete project offers received
- 40 TNC meetings with 151 LAG representatives
- 43 % TNC meetings called by France (also: Czech Republic, Italy & Romania)
- Tourism (27%) most popular topic of TNC meetings
- 50% / 50% Premature concept / advanced concept of discussed project offers
- \* 82% Meetings found potential partners for cooperation




#### **Number of project offers per topic**

(72 project offers received)






# Social/Educational & Culture: project offers per MS

# TNC issues raised at the LEADER Event (1) (LEADER consultation)

- Cooperation budget not available for 2012 or the rest of the programming period
  - Conflict with Art. 39.4 of Reg. 1974/2006: « the cooperation projects may be submitted by the LAGs to the MAs by 31/12/2013»
  - Effect: cooperation is not opened to all territories
  - Solution: to transfer resources to measure 421 & reserve a budget line until 12/2013



#### TNC issues raised at the LEADER Event (2)

(LEADER consultation)

- Different timing in decision-making and lengthy procedure
  - Effect: LAGs are replacing cooperation partners
  - Solution: respect the guidelines & to apply an on-going application system proposed for post 2013
- Differences in eligibility of cooperation partners
  - In some MS the LAG cannot be beneficiary of measure 421 & in other only LAGs can be beneficiaries
  - Solution: improve the exchange of information between MAs





#### **Follow-up plan of TNC meetings** (1)

#### **Objectives:**

- to monitor the exact number of the projects established after the LEADER event
- to provide direct specific support for the LAGs still in difficulties after the LEADER event to find partners







#### Follow-up plan of TNC meetings (2)

#### **Actions:**

- ➢ e-mail to all LAG representatives who participated in the event with e.g. summary of expression of interest for cooperation
- > report on TNC aspect of the LEADER Event with statistic on LAG matchmaking results
- First evaluation of the results of launching new wave of TNC projects (based on survey, interview, specific support) by end of September
- Final results on *number of the projects established* after the LEADER event to be presented during <u>next LsC meeting</u> November 2012
