The ENRD is launching a new topic for its thematic work: '[Mainstreaming the Bioeconomy](#) [1]'. Activities over the next year will include: meetings of a new Thematic Group (TG) composed of a wide range of stakeholders; analytical work; and a concluding European Seminar.

The overall objective of the thematic work is to encourage the development of sustainable bioeconomy value chains in rural areas in order to promote economic growth and employment whilst preserving eco-systems.
