Assessing RDP Effects on Achieving Balanced Territorial Development of Rural Economies and Communities



Working Package 1, of the thematic working group analysed the emerging evaluation issues identified in relation to the assessment of RDP's effects on achieving balanced territorial development of rural economies and communities. The issues have been collected during the analysis of the evaluation sections of the AIRs submitted in 2019, the feedback from evaluation stakeholders in the EvaluationWORKS! events and complementary interviews with evaluation stakeholders in the Member States. Four topics were selected:

1. share of the rural population benefiting from new/improved services/infrastructures;
2. jobs created in rural areas;
3. reporting on net contributions of socio-economic impact indicators;
4. quantification of LEADER/CLLD contributions and measuring their secondary effects.

The issues identified in the four topics are generally related to the availability and quality of data, double counting, different interpretations of methodologies among Member States, difficulties in aggregating data at the EU and in some cases at the national level.

The Evaluation Helpdesk has launched the Thematic Working Group 'Ex post evaluation of RDPs 2014-2020: Learning from practice' (TWG 8) in the beginning of this year. This thematic working group aims to address the challenges in the assessment of RDP achievements and impacts identified in the AIR submitted in 2019 and to support Member States in preparing for the ex post evaluation of the RDPs 2014-2020.

L'évaluation des effets des PDR sur la réalisation d'un développement territorial équilibré des économies et des communautés rurales. Ces questions ont été recueillies lors de l'analyse des sections relatives à l'évaluation des RAMO soumis en 2019, des réactions des parties prenantes de l'évaluation dans le cadre des événements EvaluationWORKS! et de l'analyse des entretiens complémentaires avec les parties prenantes de l'évaluation dans les États membres. Quatre thèmes ont été sélectionnés:

1. la part de la population rurale bénéficiant de services/infrastructures nouveaux/améliorés;
2. les emplois créés dans les zones rurales;
3. le rapport des contributions nettes des indicateurs d'impact socio-économique;
4. l'estimation des contributions LEADER/CLLD et la mesure de leurs effets secondaires.

Les problèmes recensés dans les quatre thèmes sont généralement liés à la disponibilité et à la qualité des données, au double comptage, aux interprétations différentes de la méthodologie selon les États membres à la difficulté d'agréger les données à l'échelle de l'UE et, parfois à l'échelle nationale.

Data Management for the Assessment of RDP Effects



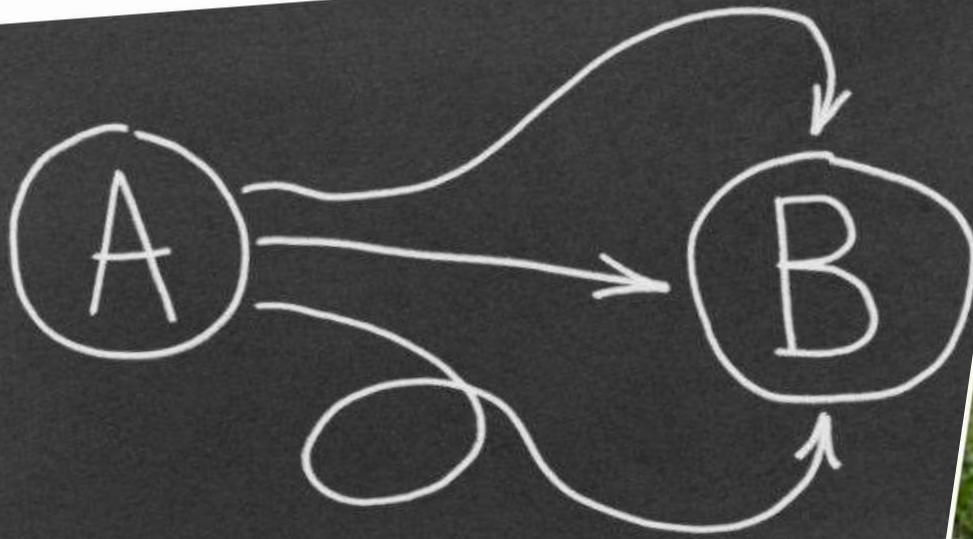
The Farm Accountancy Data Network



*Old MacDonald had a farm, E-I-E-I-O!
And on his farm he had a cow, E-I-E-I-O!*

Farm level data is essential for monitoring and evaluating the achievements of the CAP and for better targeting of CAP support. The Farm Accountancy Data Network (FADN) plays a crucial role in this endeavour. It is the only instrument that provides harmonised micro-economic data for farms in the EU. Derived from national surveys, the data is not only used to evaluate the income of agricultural holdings, but also, increasingly to assess the overall achievements and impacts of the Common Agricultural Policy.

Appraisal of the intervention strategy



What's the shortest way from A – B?

Planning an effective strategy is an important step in any process when one is trying to achieve a specific goal. Once you have developed your strategy how do you know it is really the right strategy? How do you know if it is the most effective strategy? And will it be the strategy to get you from A → B?

All of these questions and more can be answered through a robust appraisal of your strategy, only after which will you have a clearer picture if the strategy planned is the right one to meet your goals and objectives.
