TOUR 1 : LE MEZENC EXAMPLE, AN INHABITED MOUNTAIN THANKS TO TOURISM

Local products that give strong local identity (Beef Fin Gras du Mézenc), social integration of new inhabitants in rural communities (Domaine des Marmottes, production of strawberries), collective project between farmers to organize direct selling for tourists (Farmers Mézenc), Managing an emblematic tourist site (Les Estables outdoor resort).



TOUR 2 : LA MARGERIDE EXAMPLE, HERITAGE AREA CROSSED BY THE SANTIAGO CAMINO PATH PILGRIMAGE

Collective project between farmers to organize direct selling for tourists (Le Sauvage), Restoration of historic buildings located on the path Santiago camino (Domaine du Sauvage), touristic development, Transformation of primary products (milk) into end-consumer products (cheese) for local touristic markets (GAEC des Fleurines), farm with photovoltaic plant



TOUR 3 : LE VELAY D'ALTITUDE EXAMPLE, RICH VOLCANIC SOIL AT THE GATES OF THE CITY

Agriculture that take advantage from local farmland specificities (Green Lentils du Puy), Agricultural diversification by transformation of primary products (Le Velay cheese), Direct selling (Le Puy en Velay market, link between urban and rural development), touristic development through a European Cultural Route (Stevenson route), agri-tourism activities and local branding (Ferme auberge of L' Arrestadou)





TOUR4 : LE VELAY DES VALLÉES, A CLOSER CONNECTION TO THE NEARBY URBAN AREA

Vegetable production through social inclusion projects in the suburban areas (Jardin des Estreys), local crops producers brought by a common project (The Beer Vellavia), link between urban and rural areas Le Puy en Velay market), a common brand for several cheese producers (Chabrirou du Velay), production of a locally innovative product Trouts in Vourzac).



TOUR 5 : LE FOREZ EXAMPLE, RAISE AWARENESS AROUND THE AREA (FESTIVE PROMOTION OF LOCAL PRODUCE

A local breed of sheep (Agneau Noir du Velay), Volcanism and agricultural production, raise awareness around local know-how (the potatoe Cooperative du haut Velay), Potatoe promotion through local fest (the Trifolia), Role of a gastronomes' guild for local production (La Rapée, potaoe speciality)
