<b>Exchange objectives</b>	<p>Skills to be learned:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Practical farm work: milking, feeding, cleaning, tractor driving etc.;</li> <li>• Sharing of agricultural knowledge across countries: horticulture.</li> </ul>
<b>Group determination</b>	Travel to farm's exchange programmes are intended for those between 18 and 30 years of age and that have at least 12 months' experience working in agriculture. Travel to Farm offers the opportunity to travel and work in agriculture, horticulture and / or rural household.
<b>Number of participants</b>	About 100 exchange students go abroad each year. About 100 exchange students are received in Denmark each year.
<b>Recruitment</b>	<p>The participant must meet the following requirements:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Age between 18 and 30;</li> <li>• Practical experience of at least 1 year within the area the participant wants to work in;</li> <li>• Unmarried;</li> <li>• Driving license for car;</li> <li>• Speak and understand English.</li> </ul>
<b>Destination(s)</b>	Canada, Australia, the Netherland, Ireland, Norway, Sweden, Switzerland, Germany, Japan, New Zealand, USA.
<b>Duration of an exchange</b>	3 to 12 months.
<b>Costs</b>	<p>The participant must pay the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• A fixed administration fee to Travel to Farm;</li> <li>• Fee to Travel to Farms' partner in the internship country;</li> <li>• Travel to/from the internship country;</li> <li>• Insurance;</li> <li>• Visa (all countries outside the EU and Switzerland).</li> </ul> <p>For the fee the trainee gets:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Help with application, insurance, flights, visas;</li> <li>• Information session at Travel to Farm;</li> <li>• Trainee-salary, as well as room and board with host family;</li> <li>• In some cases, you can get a higher gross salary, but must do more work (for example cook): it is different from location to location;</li> </ul>



Scheme name	Travel to Farm
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Possibility of a travel grant from Ole Heye Foundation;</li><li>• Scholarship List of other scholarships that you can apply to cover your stay;</li><li>• To work with an internship approved host family;</li><li>• The right to leave (without pay) during the stay;</li><li>• Welcome seminar in the host country with other trainees (all overseas Programmes);</li><li>• Safety nets: you can always contact either partner in the host country or Travel to Farm in Denmark.</li></ul>
<b>Selection of farmers (guests) and hosts</b>	<p>The participant must submit an application that contains a personal description and qualifications.</p> <p>When a host apply for one of Travel to Farm's interns, they usually receive several intern suggestions that they can choose from so they can find the person who fits their farm. Travel to Farm say no to unsuitable hosts and interns.</p>
<b>Insurance</b>	Travel to Farm helps to order insurance at favourable prices
<b>Language conditions</b>	The participant must speak and understand English
