## ALL MEASURES INVESTMENTS BY SECTOR








GDP and % of GPD mobilised (2013)

#### Findings reported in CEQ29: Territorial development

## Main limitations of the approach

- Investments realised in 2018 are not included in Data Bases (FADN)
- Not enough time for the RDP to produce impacts
- Complex indicators (rates, poverty, rural typology) that depend on the evolution of several factors (R2, I14, I15, I16,...)
- Lack of available information (income, poverty...) in municipalities under 1.000 inhabitants
- RDP impacts on poverty are actually indirect
- The time to undertake evaluation activities is too short
- Redundancy of information in several question (employment, poverty, competitiveness, ...)

# Recommendations for the RDP expost evaluation in 2023

- Simplify the number of common evaluation questions
  - Employment: CEQ 16+CEQ22→poverty (through employment) CEQ25+CEQ29
  - Local development: CEQ17+CEQ29
  - Biodiversity: CEQ 8+CEQ 26+CEQ28
  - Innovation: 5 evaluation questions
- Simplify the calculation of results and impacts indicators:
  - Secondary contributions
  - Rate: energy/standard output (industries?)
  - Impacts: XX/ population.
- More support for methodology: good practices, guidelines, real experiences.
