#### Use of AIRs in DG AGRI

- Desk officers
  - Bilateral
  - State of play; Cause and effect; Performance framework; ARMs
- Management/Horizontal services
  - Horizontal overview
  - Steering/ARMs; Policy implications
- Reporting
  - EU level achievements



- Priority 1 Knowledge transfer/innovation
  - Progress tending to lag
    Training better (40%!)
  - Small budgets but high impact <4% RDPs
  - Knock-on effect on other priorities





- Priority 2 Farm competitiveness/forestry
  - FA 2A and 2B good progress (42%, 60%, but small 1.2%, 0.9% holdings)
  - Achievements in line with expenditure (exceptions in both directions)



FA 2C lagging

Forestry seems to be an issue



- Priority 3 Food chain/risk management
  - FA 3A implementation mostly processing
  - Low progress for farmers' participation in value chain/risk management (exceptions: IT..)

32% of 3A target (only 0.6% farmers); 3B = 28% = 1.4% farmers

? Contribution to farm competitiveness





- Priority 4 Ecosystems
  - Highest achievements for agricultural targets (as non-cumulative)

(Biodiv 94%/16%; Soil 85%/12%; Water 84%/12%)

- Sufficient resources to cover contracts/ANCs?
- Forestry progress low ⊗

(Biodiv 21%/0,4%; Soil 17%/0.2%; Water 14%/0.1%)





- Priority 5 Climate/resource efficiency
  - FA 5A good progress (40%)
     Lower costs; Phased projects
  - FA 5B/5C ca 17% of target
    Achievements (CRIs) largely missing
  - FA 5D/5E targets v low, but good progress





- Priority 6 Rural development/infrastructure
  - FA 6A low progress (14%)
    In line with €
  - FA 6B coverage © (113% = 53% rural pop) + progress on services/jobs

Biggest concern = lack of wider achievements. Why?

FA 6C slow progress

Time needed to get going; Understandable slow start





# **Final points**

- Big leap in 2018 ☺
- Keep the focus on results/objectives: avoid shifting € to speed absorption
- Pay attention to smaller budgets with high potential impact (P1, forestry, P5)
- Improve accuracy
- Leader monitoring!
- Learn from CEQ answers for CAP Plan
- Use CMEF to prepare for PMEF!!!
