
Multi-annual framework for ENRD CP activities

New topics of time-bound importance to MAs and PA's and from the EC's perspective may be identified during the course of the year, and events organised accordingly








P5 – (Proposed Thematic Group 'Mainstreaming the bio-economy')










Number of participations at events








Number of events organised (indicate number by theme)














Number good practice/project examples both collected and disseminated by thematic focus













Number of good practice/project examples both collected and disseminated


