6 – 8 December 2016 Båstad, Sweden.

Please note that if you are going to travel by train from Copenhagen airport to Båstad, **the ticket must be purchased before boarding the train**. It is not possible to buy a ticket once on board, and passengers without a ticket might be fined by the train company.

- ID check - The Swedish authorities check IDs of all passengers travelling by train to Sweden. Passengers will require photo ID to travel from Copenhagen Airport to Sweden, for more details please see <https://www.dsb.dk/kampagner/id-kontrol/id-inspection/>
- If in doubt, bring your passport

If arriving by train to Båstad train station, there will be shuttle buses available as follows. The buses will be situated in front of the station, indicating the name of the seminar and the hotel.
