Cooperation PWG – Outcomes, Issues



- More detailed description of joint actions and common costs;
- Generic cooperation agreement template developed;
- Information sharing:
 - preparatory support template;
 - project information sheet etc.;
- DG AGRI Guidance updated.



- Information gaps remain;
- Diversity of rules at MS level.





Support to LEADER Cooperation



- ✓ Validated, basic data for 3 058 LAGs (2 745 EAFRD funded);
- ✓ Includes EAFRD, EMFF, ESF and ERDF funded LAGs;
- ✓ Advanced version launched integrated with cooperation partner search tool;
- ✓ LAGs can manage and upload their profiles – including partner search offers.



The LEADER Innovation PWG


