



- Once a call is opened it should remain open *window of opportunity...

Themes

- the "ideal" process for TNC

- demonstrating the the "added value" of TNC
- preparatory support for TNC

Membership

- 46 members from 20 EU member states + other networks, organisations (FARNET, ELARD, EURAF) and the European Commission
- 16 members are also members of the LEADER Sub-Group
- 17 Local Action Groups, 7
 Managing Authorities, 3

 Paying Agencies, 11
 NRNs/NSUs in membership
- EU MSs represented: AT, BE, HR, EE, FI, DE, EL, HU, IE, IT, LV, LT, PL, PT, SK, SL, ES, SE, NL, UK

 LAGs by NRNs, the importance
 of understanding the use of
 preparatory support for
 "exploring" project feasibility,

 project applications
- common definition of 'joint action' and 'common costs' proposed
- a generic template for cooperation agreements proposed
- several examples of relevant EU MS practice available online


