

Slovenia: approaching project holders

How to first identify practices?

- NRN/NSU launched an open call to RDP INFO points for collection of practices
- A common template for identification prepared
- Only completed & paid out projects collected
- 1 person within NSU currently appointed to coordinate collection
- Initial checks comprise:
 - content (advisors, project holders)
 - financial & administrative (PA)







Slovenia: approaching project holders

Other ways of identifying potential good practices:

- Personal contacts and networks ...
- Events organized where projects/beneficiaries are presented (e.g. annual meetings with young farmers, LAG Festival, events of the Chamber of agriculture and forestry ...)
- Trade fairs (e.g. Gornja Radgona)
- Media (presenting project activities)
- RDP evaluation activities
- Lists of approved projects (measure, topics, beneficiaries)





Does the identified practice have potential to become a good practice case?



- No recipe or standard model to follow, each project has its own story
- Interview with the project holder and
- On the spot visits are key
- **Be curious**, sometimes it is the interview that actually helps the project holder to reveal the bigger picture





Does the identified practice have a potential to become a good practice case?

Things to consider:



- the story and motives behind the project,
- how the **results** are used and by whom,
- unexpected side effects of the project,
- importance of the project for a wider community
- what changes have been noted,
- did the project encourage new activities, employment, new partnerships, etc.





Slovenia: what are the challenges?

Working with project holders:

- Limited resources to make site visits
- Availability of the project holder (high season)
- Creating a safe and open atmosphere to discuss the practice
- Adapting communication to project holders
- Fact checking
- Time perspective



RDP implementation point of view:

 Measures with potential interesting projects started late (e.g. Cooperation, EIP, LEADER, producer groups)
