

Demonstrating the Added Value of Networking

There is a consensus among 'rural networkers' that networks can, and in most cases do, make a valuable contribution to rural development, and in particular to the improvement of Rural Development Programme implementation.

However, the added value of networking is often not understood outside of the 'networking circle'. Managing Authorities in particular need to understand how NRNs can be used as a tool to improve policy. Therefore, networks are facing the specific challenge of demonstrating the added value of networking for those not directly involved in it.
