How CLLD works in Tyrol

The LAG is a one-stop-shop for all kinds of funding in one region (single structure)

- The LAG is the catalyst for strategic development within a single region
- There is one local development strategy with several action fields in different funds
- Multi-funded and sometimes also cross-border LDS and its implementation
- Harmonisation of administrative obstacles between different funds on regional and provincial level

Own budget on regional level (LAG) for CLLD implementation alongside LEADER.



How CLLD is used

Multi-funded CLLD is used in three main focus areas, along with LEADER:

1. Support to SMEs in the field of Research and Innovation;
2. Management of natural areas and protection against natural hazards;
3. Linking rural and urban areas: connecting 'Smart Cities' and 'Smart Villages'.

Lessons learnt

A LAG needs to transition from a funding source to a multi-level and multi-issue development agency.

Sufficient management resources – financial and labour – are needed to efficiently support LAG operation.

A common understanding of CLLD between the local and national levels is necessary.

CLLD works, if the LAG mediates bottom-up and top-down initiatives.
